DOUGLAS COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE NOW ACCEPTS CREDIT CARDS

The Douglas County Clerk's office is now accepting credit and debit cards. Customers now have the option to pay with a credit or debit card.

The Douglas County Clerk is responsible for collecting payments for services including:

- Licenses, including Marriage, Liquor and Tobacco
- Certified Copies of Documents
- Copies of Property Valuation Protests

Tom Cavanaugh, the Douglas County Clerk, said "We are pleased to now be allowed to offer our customers the convenient option to pay with a credit card. This easy and efficient card system will also help our customers with phone and online transactions."

The Douglas County Clerk is the first office in Douglas County, as well as the first Clerk's office in the state, to use the system created by Nebraska.gov, the State's eGovernment provider.

Customers who decide to use the credit/debit card option will pay a minimal additional fee to Nebraska.gov. There are no monthly maintenance fees charged to Douglas County to use this service.
