PROHORT EDUCATION PROGRAM

This horticulture education program is for garden center employees or anyone wanting to obtain in-depth information about gardening, landscaping, lawn care, etc. Participants who attend all classes and pass a proficiency test will receive a Certificate of Completion of ProHort Education, which can be displayed in their place of business.

Cost: \$395 for entire course, which includes the price of the handbook. Additional employees from the same company are \$350.

Per-session Cost: \$50 one-day session. \$25 per half-day session (please indicate morning or afternoon).
