

Cases reported through October 17, 2014









2006 - 2015



## Reported by Sentinel Providers in Douglas County, Nebraska, West North Central Region\* and USA 2014 - 2015 Flu Season




\* West North Central Region includes Nebraska, Kansas, Missouri, and Iowa

Reported through October 15, 2014



Week 48 is Thanksgiving week. Only 1/3 of the county's enrollment is in session that week. The break in the graph lines, from week 51 - week 1, is for Christmas Break when schools are not in session. Week 2 in 2010 and week 5 in 2013 had no school due to inclement weather.
