


Sexually Transmitted Diseases Douglas County, NE 2001-2015





Number of Chlamydia Cases by Age Group Douglas County, NE 2014 - 2015







Percentage of Chlamydia Cases by Age Group Douglas County, NE 2014 - 2015



Chlamydia Rates by Age Group Douglas County, NE 2006 – 2015*



Number of Chlamydia Cases by Race/Ethnicity Douglas County, NE 2014 - 2015






Percentage of Chlamydia Cases by Race/Ethnicity Douglas County, NE 2014 - 2015

Chlamydia Rates by Race/Ethnicity Douglas County, NE 2006-2015*







Number of Gonorrhea Cases by Age Group Douglas County, NE 2014 - 2015



Gonorrhea Cases by Age Group Douglas County, Nebraska 2015



Percentage of Gonorrhea Cases by Age Group Douglas County, NE 2014 - 2015





Number of Gonorrhea Cases by Race/Ethnicity Douglas County, NE 2014 - 2015





Percentage of Gonorrhea Cases by Race/Ethnicity Douglas County, NE 2014 - 2015




Chlamydia Rates by ZIP Code






Chlamydia Rates by ZIP Code Females, 15 to 24 Age Group Douglas County, Nebraska - Five Year Average

2011 - 2015






Gonorrhea Rates by ZIP Code Both Sexes, 15 to 24 Age Group Douglas County, Nebraska - Five Year Average




STD Clinic Visits per Year
