

# Notice of General Election

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, the 6th of November, 2018 at the usual polling places in the election precincts of Douglas County, Nebraska, a general election will be held. The polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Said election will be for electing candidates for various offices. All races will not appear on every general election ballot as the candidates are elected by specific subdivisions, districts, or wards. At the same time, an initiative will be voted upon by the voters of the State of Nebraska. The Secretary of State will publish a true copy of the title and text of the initiative once each week for three consecutive weeks preceding the election. **Issue(s) Appearing on the General Ballot**

**Gretna Public Schools Bond Election**

“Shall Sarpy County School District 0037 (Gretna Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its general obligation bonds in an aggregate stated principal amount not to exceed Eighty-Five Million Dollars (\$85,000,000), for the purpose of paying costs of new facilities and improvements to existing facilities of the District, which may include (1) constructing, furnishing and equipping two new elementary schools; (2) acquiring sites and constructing infrastructure and site improvements for future school facilities; (3) constructing, furnishing and equipping technology and security improvements to District buildings and facilities; and (4) constructing, furnishing and equipping improvements at the High School and other District facilities; such bonds to be issued from time to time, to bear interest at such rate or rates, to be sold at such prices and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by, or determined at the direction of, the Board of Education; and “Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due?”
